- ◆ Existing Registered or Licensed providers using EIP funds to pay for above training **MUST** enclose their EIP voucher, or if a voucher has not been received, a copy of their completed EIP application or fax coversheet (on-line EIP applicants only) with check payment when registering. Child & Family Resources will refund payment to provider once EIP voucher has been submitted and paid.
- ◆ Existing Registered or Licensed providers needing CPR/FA.
- ◆ **OCFS Topics: 2(NH), 4 (SS), 5 (BR), 6 (CA), 7 (SDC), 8 (SCA), 9 (SBS)**

- Participants **must bring photo ID** to first session
- Potential Providers using grant funding to cover mandated sessions 1-6 **MUST** have pre-approval before attending and are still required to pay the \$40.00 non-refundable registration fee.
- Potential Providers are not eligible to apply for EIP voucher to cover session fees.
